Facilitating Health-Related System Integration to Benefit the Needs of the Whole Child and Facilitate Sustainable Health Outcomes









- Add a field to your Electronic Medical Record system to facilitate the collection of the Cyber ID, the unique identifier for the youth served through the NJ Children's System of Care (CSOC). Families approve the addition of the Cyber ID sticker to their family insurance card.
- Intake/Reception staff can be trained to watch for the yellow Cyber ID sticker on the family insurance card which identifies Bergen's Promise youth. Contacting CMO upon admission to begin aligning follow-up services and streamlined communication between care teams.
- Crisis planning in the event of a crisis and the youth is admitted or screened at New Bridge Medical Ctr., this facilitates immediate support of the youth/family by enabling the Care Management Organization to begin coordination of services prior to them leaving.
- Coordinate discharge planning for Behavioral Health Home youth to support coordinated follow up care.
- Facilitate smooth transition of youth back into their community
- Potential for collaboration regarding health outcomes for shared youth.
